RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VACAVILLE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT APPROVING ADJUSTMENTS TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT'S TRUSTEE AREAS PURSUANT TO EDUCATION CODE SECTION 5019.5

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (“Board”) of the Vacaville Unified School District (“District”) is elected under a “by trustee area” election system wherein each trustee resides within one of seven trustee areas and each trustee is elected only by the registered voters of the trustee area they represent; and

WHEREAS, following each decennial federal census (“Census”), school districts that utilize by trustee area elections must adjust the boundaries of any or all of the trustee areas as necessary to meet the population criteria set forth in Education Code section 5019.5, subdivision (a); and

WHEREAS, Education Code section 5019.5, subdivision (b), provides that the boundaries of the trustee areas shall be adjusted by the Board, in accordance with subdivision (a), before the first day of March of the year following the year in which the results of the Census are released; and

WHEREAS, Michael Wagaman, demographer from Wagaman Strategies (“Demographer”), a California-based elections and governmental consulting firm experienced in redistricting issues and requirements, was retained to assist the District in analyzing the 2020 Census data (“2020 Census”) and preparing a trustee area redistricting plan for the Board’s and public’s consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Board has conferred with and received guidance and advice from Demographer regarding the current demographic population in the territory of the Board’s jurisdiction, based on the official 2020 Census results, and determined that adjustments to the Board’s current trustee area boundaries must be made as a result of the 2020 Census results; and

WHEREAS, Demographer and District legal counsel have reviewed for the Board the procedures and policy criteria governing redistricting; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2021, the Board conducted a duly noticed public meeting to provide information and get preliminary direction on potential changes to trustee areas; and

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2021, the Demographer presented the Board with four map adjustment options and the Board held a public hearing to solicit public testimony, input, and comments from the public on the proposed redistricting plans; and

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2022, the Board held a further public hearing and received input from Demographer, and identified the map preferred by the Board; and

WHEREAS, the map identified by the Board as the preferred redistricting map is attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and now entitled the “Proposed Final” (hereinafter the “Proposed Final Map”); and

WHEREAS, the trustee areas in the Proposed Final Map have population that are reasonably equal, in compliance with legal requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Proposed Final Map provides for a single-member, by trustee area electoral system, that complies with the California Voting Rights Act (Elec. Code, § 14025, *et seq.*), Section 2 of the Federal Voting Rights Act (42 U.S.C. § 1973), and all other applicable laws.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees of the Vacaville Unified School District hereby resolves as follows:

1. The above recitals are correct and true.
2. The Board hereby adopts the Proposed Final Map (attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference) as its official trustee area redistricting plan pursuant to Education Code section 5019.5 and other relevant provisions of law.
3. The Proposed Final Plan is based on the 2020 Census and complies with relevant law.
4. The District Superintendent or designee, in conjunction with the Demographer, is hereby authorized and directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the County Superintendent of Schools, and to work with the County Elections Office to conduct any additional acts necessary to complete the redistricting process in a timely fashion to permit implementation of these trustee areas in connection with the election to be held on November 8, 2022, including, without limitation, minor adjustments to the adopted map as may be necessary for its implementation.

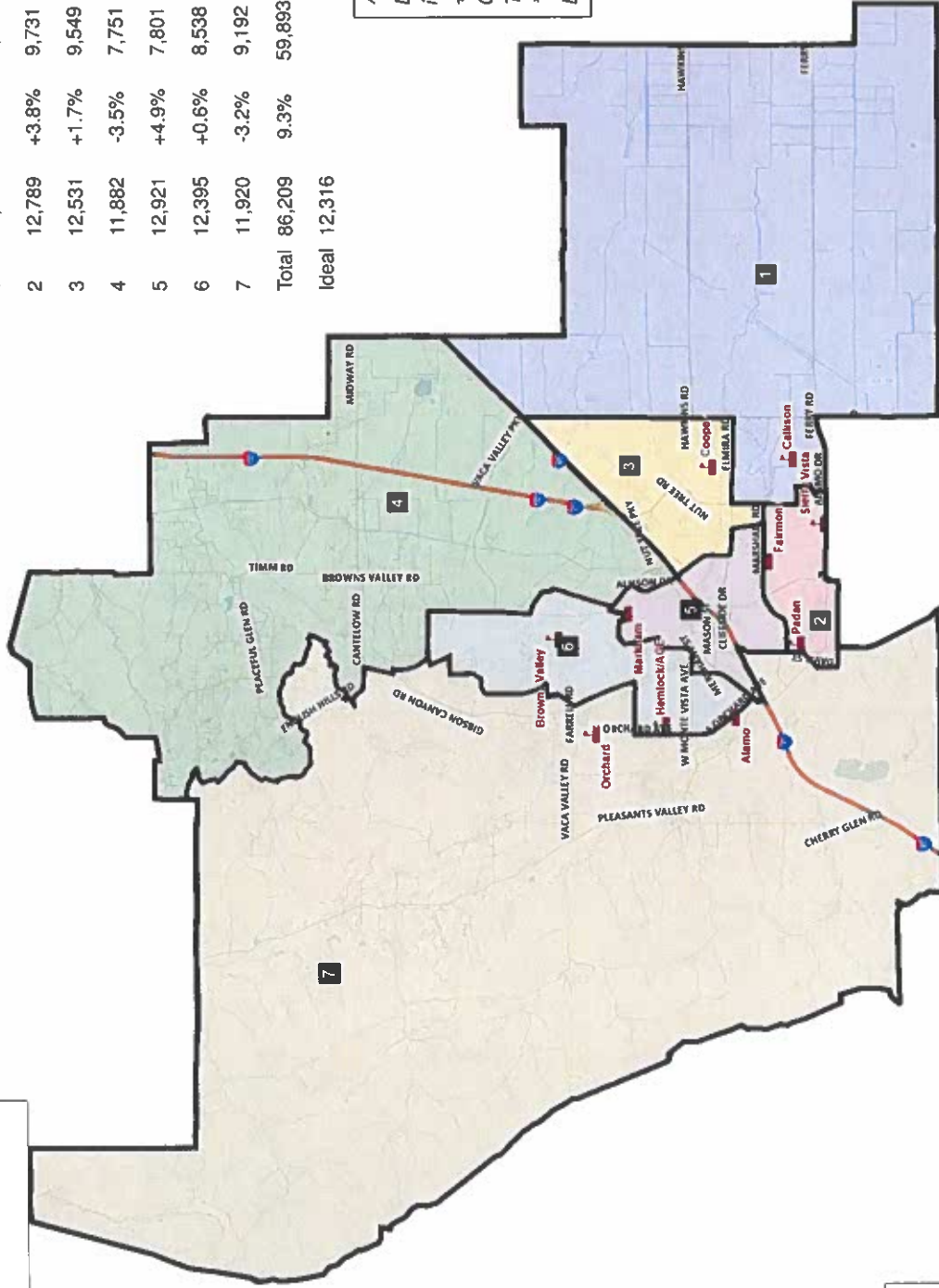

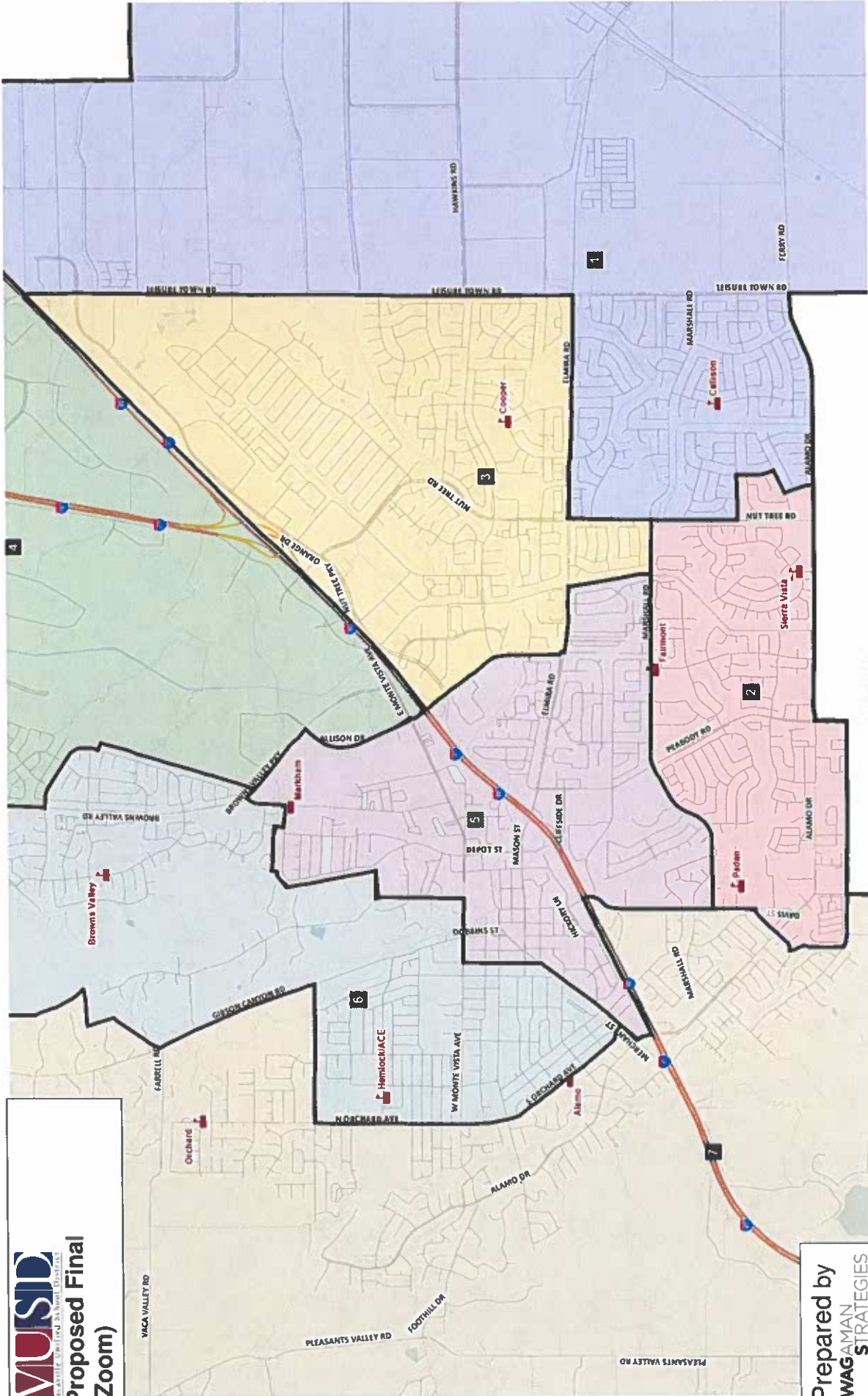
